DURATION OF STUDY

The programme is offered on full time and offshore basis. For the offshore programme, it is a twelve months program with all lectures conducted on weekend in the UTM Kuala Lumpur campus.

The full duration of the programme is 3 semesters (12 months) while the maximum duration of the programme is 6 semesters (24 months)

The programme consists of 15 Learning Packages (LP01 to LP15). At the end of the learning process, student's performance will be assessed using two assessment methods: Knowledge Assessment (KA) and Performance Assessment (PA).
